PUBLIC NOTICE No. 38/2019

DOCTORATE-CLASS SELECTION 2020

The rector of the State University of Ceará (UECE), Prof. Dr. José Jackson Coelho Sampaio, in the use of its statutory and regimental attributions, makes public the opening of this public notice for inscriptions for selection, at Doctoral level, to the **Clinical care in Nursing and Health Postgraduation Program (PPCCLIS)**. 18 (eighteen) vacancies will be offered, distributed in the two research lines of the program:

- 1- **Fundamentals and practices of clinical care in nursing and health;**
- 2- **Policies and management for clinical practice in nursing and health;**

The program aims to train scientists in nursing and other health areas capable of leading teams to investigate new scientific, technological and innovative knowledge in the area of nursing and health, with a view to improving the health and life of the population and qualify professors to work in higher education in the area of nursing and health.

1. Registrations

Remarks:

- 1) The documentation required for registration must be delivered within a single envelope, consisting of a signed identification label, glued to the front, the model of which is in **Annex 1**. Entries sent BY SEDEX should have two envelopes, the external being addressed to the Clinical care in Nursing and Health Postgraduation Program and the other sealed and with the aforementioned label.
- 2) The candidate residing outside Fortaleza may register by public proxy or perform the registration by mail (via SEDEX) posted in the Post office, until **August 30th, 2019**.
- 3) The selection will be made by research line and by Advisor. Each applicant must register for one of the research lines of the program and for the intended advisor, presenting a research proposal related to the subject of the advisor.
- 4) Acceptance of the application is conditional on the submission of all the following documents, in a printed form. In the absence of one of the documents, the application for registration will be rejected. It is recommended that the documents be arranged and bound in the order described below:
 - a) Application form, available on the website of PPCCLIS on the Internet <http://www.uece.br/ppcclis>, with the indication of an advisor among the professors of the program and accompanied by two recent 3x4 photos;
 - b) Original voucher for payment of the registration fee, in the amount of R\$200.00 (two hundred reais), paid in any agency of Banco do Brasil, in the Current Account No. 26038-X, agency 008-6; By deposit or bank transfer in favor of *Stricto Sensu/IEPRO/UECE*;
 - c) Copy of the identity card, driver's license or work card and CPF;
 - d) Copy of the updated *Curriculum vitae*, in the Lattes model, accompanied by copies of the

evidentiary documents;

- e) Copy of the Master's diploma, or statement of defense of the dissertation with a defense date not exceeding 12 months, or statement with prediction of defense of the dissertation until the date of the first registration in the PPCCLIS;
- f) Copy of the school history of the undergraduate course;
- g) Copy of the National Register of Foreigners (RNE) and proof of proficiency in Portuguese (CELPE-BRAS) for foreign candidates;
- h) Original statement of time availability to devote to the course, provided by the employment institution, or hand-written statement, by the applicant, in case there is no employment bond;
- i) Copy of proof of proficiency in English language and another language, except Portuguese, issued by public educational institutions in Brazil, if the applicant has it;
- j) Pre-project thesis in three (03) copies: One copy with the data identifiers of the pre-project (pre-project title, specifying the line of research, the advisor and their respective theme and **with** identification and Signature of the author) and two copies with only the data identifiers of the pre-project (title of the pre-project, specifying the line of research, the advisor and their respective project **without** identification and signature of the author).
- k) Plan of international activities with description, in up to three pages, of activities to be developed in higher education institutions in foreign countries, aiming at the conceptual and theoretical deepening of the object of study intended, namely: 1. conducting a sandwich doctorate; 2. Technical visits; 3. Participation in events with presentation of work in the oral modality. The proposal should inform the possible place to perform a sandwich doctorate, as well as the indication of the tutor who will be responsible for the follow-up of the doctoral student.

Authentication will be required only in cases of submission of the documentation via Sedex; In the presental inscriptions, there will be the conference between the copies presented and the original documents, after which, the envelope will be sealed.

2. Vacancies

In this public notice, the program offers 18 vacancies for doctorate, distributed **in two lines of research** and Advisors' projects, as shown in the table below.

The vacancies will be distributed according to the thematic fields of research, among the permanent professors of the program, according to the presentation of table 1.

3. The selection process

The selection of candidates will be made by groups of Professors, denominated selection committees, one for each line of research at each stage of the selection. The selection committees will be designated by the Postgraduate Commission of the PPCCLIS.

The selection process comprises 03 (three) Steps: 1) curriculum analysis; 2) Evaluation of the pre-project of research and plan of international activities; 3) interview.

All the Steps have an eliminatory character.

3.1. Curriculum analysis

In this step, we evaluate:

a) **Academic and research training** - involving a postgraduate scholarship, residency in the health area, specialization in the field of health, scholarship (IC, pet-MEC, pet-health, monitoring, extension and technical support), Participation in a research group registered in CNPq/participation in research, courses in the area of health with workload equal to or greater than 40 hours and less than 80 hours, courses in the area of health with workload equal to or higher than 80 hours and less than 120 hours; And courses in the area of health with a workload equal to 120 hours; Participation in the Academic Center Board.

b) **Teaching/service Experience** - involving teaching of high and technical schools in the field of health, teaching of higher education in the field of health, preceptorship of internship and residence, participation in an Examining Board for an end of course paper of a graduation course, participation in an Examining Board for an end of course paper of a specialization course, participation in a Committee for evaluation of works in events, orientation for completion of graduation and postgraduation Lato sensu end of course paper, orientation of IC, PET, monitoring and extension scholarship and activity of clinical practice and/or management in health.

c) **Scientific production** - articles published or accepted in Qualis/CAPES Journals of the minimum extract B1 (**from January 2016 until inscriptions date**). Other Scientific Productions (**from January 2016 until inscriptions date**), complete work published in Annals of National and International events with ISSN, published book with ISBN, book chapter published with ISBN, referee/expert, lecturer in scientific events. On a scale of 0.0 (zero point zero) to 10.0 (ten point zero), the minimum score for approval is **7.0** (seven point zero).

3.2 Evaluation of the pre-project of research and the plan of internationalization activities

In this stage, the consistency and adequacy of the proposal of the candidate to the research line of the program and the Advisor's theme chosen by them is evaluated. On a scale from 0.0 (zero point zero) to 10.0 (ten point zero). The minimum score for approval for the next step is 7.0 (seven point zero). The pre-project should contain up to 15 pages, including pre-textual elements, introduction, objectives, method and references. The project should be built in accordance with the norms of ABNT.

The international activities plan should contain 3 pages and will be evaluated on the following aspects: execution potential, with design of strategies to be used, in addition to the resources expended for the execution of the same; Consonance with the thesis proposal; Indicators of contribution to doctoral training, related to the profile of institutions in the international academic panorama.

3.3 Interview

In this stage, the potentiality of the candidate to perform post-graduate studies is evaluated. The interview will be conducted around the pre-project of the candidate's research, their willingness to dedicate to the course and the development of international activities. It will be submitted to the interview only the applicants who have obtained approval in steps 1 and 2 of this subsection. On a scale from 0.0 (zero point zero) to 10.0 (ten point zero), the minimum approval score is 7.0 (seven point zero).

- Note:** 1. the convening of approved ones for the interview will be available at www.uece.br/ppclis/, @ppclis_uece and the secretariat of the program.
2. the Applicant will be disqualified if missing or arriving late for scheduling.

3.4 Final classification

The final score of the candidates to the doctorate program will be the average of the scores obtained in the evaluation of the curriculum, the analysis of the pre-project thesis and the interview, according to the following formula:

$$FS = \frac{2 \times CS + 3 \times APTPAS + 2 \times IS}{7}$$

FS: Final Score; CS: Curriculum Score; APTPAS: Analysis of the Pre-project Thesis and Plan of Activities Score; IS: Interview score.

The final average will be expressed through a score within the numerical scale of 0.0 (zero point zero) to 10.0 (ten point zero), being the minimum score for approval in the selection process: **7.0** (seven point zero).

In the case of a tie in the final average, this will be resolved considering the highest score in the **analysis of the lattes curriculum**. If the draw persists, it will be considered the highest score in the pre-project research. If the draw persists, the highest score in the interview will be considered. If the tie still persists, the highest-aged candidate will be approved.

There may be a deployment of approved candidates outside the vacancies of the initially chosen Advisor, provided that there are vacancies and acceptance by the candidate and the available Professor, regardless of the line of research originally chosen.

5. Requirements for admission and permanence in the program

5.1. Proof of the required minimum degree

It will be necessary, as a requirement for the completion of the first registration of the PPCCLIS, the proof of degree required for the candidate approved that was still concluding their master's during the selection. They will have their enrolment pending on the presentation of the **Master's diploma** or statement stating the date on which the dissertation defense occurred up to 12 months before the first registration in the course.

5.2. Proof of approval in a test of reading proficiency in English language and another foreign language, except Portuguese.

Reading proficiency will be required in English and another foreign language for all candidates approved in this selection process. The student who did not present a statement of reading proficiency in English and another language, with a score equal to or higher than 7.0 (seven point zero) in the moment of registration to the selective process, they must prove that proficiency with a statement issued by an institution during the first enrolment in the course, or up to 12 (twelve) months counted from their initial registration. The non-compliance of this recommendation will result in the course's shutdown penalty.

6. General provisions:

In all stages of this selection will be prohibited the use of electronic devices such as: cell phones, *i-pads*, *tablets*, *notebooks*, *netbooks* etc., except with the purpose of assisting the reading for candidates with visual impairment.

The release of the final results of each step will indicate only the registration numbers of the candidates approved, listed in numerical order of registration.

Vacancies will be filled by order of classification of the applicants, observing the limit of the vacancies offered.

The final number of approved candidates may be less than the number of vacancies established in this notice.

Requests for reviewing of tests will not be accepted; And the interposition of administrative appeal shall be made upon the delivery of a written document and signed by the applicant, presenting the justification of the application, together with the coordination of the Program within a period of up to 24 hours after the release of the result of each step.

There will be no appeal to the final result of the selection.

The approval and classification in the selection process do not guarantee the granting of any kind of scholarship or aid by the Clinical Care in Nursing and Health Postgraduate Program. When available, the grant of scholarships will be governed by the standards and criteria of the funding agencies and the program's scholarship committee.

7. Of the general provisions:

- The candidate's application will imply acceptance of the guidelines set forth in this public notice;
- There will be no obligation to fill the vacancies offered;
- The financial importance of registration in the selection process will not be returned under any alleged grounds;
- The candidate at the time of registration will receive an identification number which will be used in the release of scores at all stages of the selection process;
- At the end of the selection process, the candidate not approved must redeem his registration documents at the program secretariat within 30 days after the selection is concluded. After that, all

the material not redeemed will be discarded.

- The candidate approved in the selection process whose registration was made with a statement with prediction of defense of the dissertation, will only make registration if he/she presents a statement of the dissertation defense program until the last day of the first registration of the Semester in 2020.1;
- Entries which do not present the complete documentation provided for in this notice shall not be approved;
- The absence of the candidate at any stage excludes them from the selective process;
- No results will be reported by phone or email;
- It will be deemed a dropout the selected candidate who does not enroll;
- The omissive cases or unforeseen situations in this public notice will be resolved by the selection committee, heard by the Program Committee.
