

A PLASTIC OCEAN

01 *A Plastic Ocean* is a film to make you
 02 think. Think, and then act. We need to take
 03 action on our dependence on plastic. We've
 04 been producing plastic in huge quantities since
 05 the 1940s. Drink bottles, shopping bags,
 06 toiletries and even clothes are made with
 07 plastic. We live in a world full of plastic, and only
 08 a small proportion is recycled. What happens to
 09 all the rest? This is the question the film *A*
 10 *Plastic Ocean* answers. It is a documentary that
 11 looks at the impact that plastic waste has on the
 12 environment. Spoiler alert: the impact is
 13 devastating.

14 The film begins as a journey to film the
 15 largest animal on the planet, the blue whale. But
 16 during the journey the filmmakers (journalist
 17 Craig Leeson and environmental activist Tanya
 18 Streeter) make the shocking discovery of a
 19 huge, thick layer of plastic floating in the middle
 20 of the Indian Ocean. This prompts them to travel
 21 around the world to look at other areas that
 22 have been affected. In total, they visited 20
 23 locations around the world during the four years
 24 it took them to make the film. The documentary
 25 premiered in 2016, and is now on streaming
 26 services such as Netflix.

27 It's very clear that a lot of research went
 28 into the film. There are beautiful shots of the
 29 seas and marine life. These are contrasted with
 30 scenes of polluted cities and dumps full of
 31 plastic rubbish. We see how marine species are
 32 being killed by all the plastic we are dumping in
 33 the ocean. The message about our use of
 34 plastic is painfully obvious.

35 But the film doesn't only present the
 36 negative side. In the second half, the filmmakers
 37 look at what we can do to reverse the tide of
 38 plastic flowing around the world. They present
 39 short-term and long-term solutions. These
 40 include avoiding plastic containers and
 41 'single-use' plastic products as much as
 42 possible. Reuse your plastic bags and recycle
 43 as much as you can. The filmmakers also stress
 44 the need for governments to work more on
 45 recycling programmes, and look at how
 46 technology is developing that can convert plastic
 47 into fuel.

48 We make a **staggering** amount of plastic.
 49 In terms of plastic bags alone, we use five
 50 hundred billion worldwide annually. Over 300
 51 million tons of plastic are produced every year,
 52 and at least 8 million of those are dumped into
 53 the oceans. The results are disastrous, but it
 54 isn't too late to change. Once you've seen *A*

55 *Plastic Ocean*, you'll realize the time is now and
 56 we all have a role to play.
