#### JUST ADD WATER

Are you looking for a new way to exercise?
Do you want to keep cool while you burn calories? If
you answered yes, maybe it's time to get out of the
gym and into the pool.

More and more people of all ages are trying aquatic exercise. Aquatic exercise is like exercise on land, but you do it in a swimming pool. For example, you can run, walk, and do aerobics or yoga.

10 There are many advantages to aquatic 11 exercise. Your body is lighter in the water. You 12 weigh 90 percent less in the pool than at the gym. 13 That's why exercising in the pool feels easier. But 14 you burn the same number of calories as at the 15 gym. That's because it takes energy to move in the 16 water.

Aquatic exercise is also safe and easy to
learn. For most kind of aquatic exercise, you don't
even need to know how to swim. You don't need
much training. You can do it at any age. You can do
it safely with **an injury** or when you are pregnant.
You can move in ways that are not possible on land.
Some people who can not walk on land can walk
and even run in the water.

All exercise is good for you, but aquatic exercise has one more important advantage. Most people feel more relaxed when they are in the water. And that means they will probably exercise more.
