**PROVA DE LÍNGUA INGLESA****A LONG AND A HEALTHY LIFE?**

01 How long will a baby born today live? 100  
02 years? 120 years? Scientists are studying genes  
03 that could mean long life for us all.

04 There are already many, many people who have  
05 passed the landmark age of 100. In fact, there are  
06 now so many healthy, elderly people that there's a  
07 new term for them: the wellderly. These are people  
08 over the age of 80 who have no diseases such as  
09 high blood pressure, heart disease or diabetes and  
10 have never taken medicines for these conditions.

11 There have been many scientific studies of  
12 communities where a healthy old age is typical.  
13 These include places like Calabria in southern Italy  
14 and the island of Okinawa in Japan.

15 The small village of Molochio in Calabria has  
16 about 2,000 inhabitants. And of these, there are at  
17 least eight centenarians. When researchers ask  
18 people like this the secret of their long life, the  
19 answer is almost always to do with diet and is  
20 almost always the same: 'I eat a lot of fruit and  
21 vegetables.' 'A little bit, but of everything.' 'No  
22 smoking, no drinking.'

23 While in the past scientists have looked at things  
24 such as diet and lifestyle for an explanation of long  
25 life, these days they are investigating genetics. One  
26 such researcher is Eric Topol, who says, 'There  
27 must be genes that explain why these individuals  
28 are protected from the aging process.'

29 The new research into long life looks at groups  
30 of people who have a genetic connection. For  
31 example, one group of interest lives in Ecuador. In  
32 one area of the country there are a number of  
33 people with the same genetic condition. It's called  
34 Laron syndrome. The condition means that they  
35 don't grow to more than about one meter, but it also  
36 seems to give them protection against cancer and  
37 diabetes. As a result, they live longer than other  
38 people in their families. Meanwhile, on the Hawaiian  
39 island of Oahu, there's another group of long-lived  
40 men, Japanese-Americans. They have a similar  
41 gene to the Laron syndrome group.

42 Back in Calabria, scientists are trying to work out  
43 exactly how much of the longevity is due to genetics  
44 and how much to environment. By checking public  
45 records going back to the 19th century, researchers  
46 have reconstructed the family trees of 202  
47 nonagenarians and centenarians. They concluded  
48 that there were genetic factors involved. And they  
49 seemed to benefit the men more than the women –  
50 a surprising result because generally in Europe,

51 there are five times more women centenarians than  
52 men.

53 So, what really makes people live longer? It  
54 seems likely that it is an interaction of genes, the  
55 environment and probably a third factor – luck.
