02 In Ireland, it rains a lot and there isn't much
03 sun. But sometimes, when the sun comes out after
04 the rain, you can see pretty colours in the sky –
05 that's a rainbow. Old stories from Ireland say that a
06 leprechaun, a small magical man, hides his pot full
07 of gold at the end of the rainbow. You must follow
08 the rainbow to find the gold, but it's very hard.
09 Rainbows always move when you get near, and no
10 one can find the gold. In Irish culture, if you see a
11 rainbow, good things will happen.

12 B. Hawaii

13 Hawaii is called the rainbow capital of the
14 world. After light rain, often the sun comes out, and
15 you can see the rainbow. In Native Hawaiian
16 culture, rainbows are signs that people receive from
17 the gods. Some people believe that rainbows help
18 the spirits of dead people travel from the human
19 world to another world. In Hawaii, a rainbow
20 reminds people they are not alone because
21 someone always looks after them.

22 C. South Africa

23 In some African cultures, a rainbow may be a
24 spirit that looks like a snake, bringing good or bad
25 luck, depending on how it feels. For this reason,
26 many people think that a rainbow is a message that
27 something big – good or bad – is going to happen
28 soon.

28 D. Australia

30 In Aboriginal Australian stories, there's a
31 powerful snake called the Rainbow Serpent that
32 lives in water, and it's very old. The Rainbow
33 Serpent made rivers, mountains, and lakes when
34 planet Earth was born. If people respect the land,
35 the snake will be good to them. If they don't, it may
36 bring storms or floods. For Aboriginal people, the
37 rainbow helps us remember that we have to respect
38 nature.

39 E. Scandinavia

40 In the north of Europe, old stories say that the
41 rainbow is a bridge called Bifröst. It's the bridge
42 between our world and Asgard, the home of the
43 gods like Odin and Thor. Only gods and brave
44 people can walk across it. The guardian at the
45 beginning of the bridge stops bad people from
46 entering Asgard.
