 03 weeks without it! That's exactly what happened to
 04 me recently, and let me tell you, it was quite the
 05 experience.

 19 sketching, which was incredibly rewarding.

20 I also realised how much I had been relying on
 21 my phone for social interactions. Instead of texting
 22 my friends, I started calling them or even meeting
 23 them in person. Our conversations were deeper,
 24 and I felt more connected to them than ever before.

25 My sleeping patterns improved as well. Without
 26 the blue light of my phone disturbing me late at
 27 night, I was able to fall asleep faster and had a
 28 better quality of sleep.

28 By the end of the two weeks, I was surprised to
 30 find that I wasn't in a hurry to get my phone fixed. I
 31 had learned to appreciate the world around me and
 32 the value of real connections.

33 When I finally did get my phone back, I decided
 34 to set some boundaries. I no longer spend hours on
 35 social media and make an effort to meet my friends
 36 in person. I even keep my phone away from my bed
 37 at night.

38 My phone breaking down was a blessing in
 39 disguise. It taught me to unplug and experience life
 40 more fully. And though I'm glad to have it back, I'm
 41 equally glad for the lessons those two weeks
 42 without it taught me.

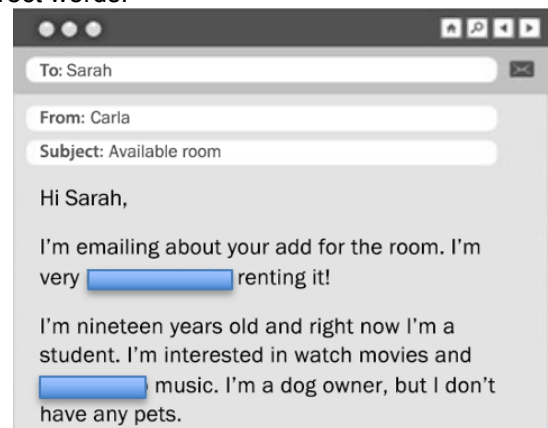
