25 My sleeping patterns improved as well. Without the blue light of my phone disturbing me late at 26 27 night, I was able to fall asleep faster and had a 28 better quality of sleep.

By the end of the two weeks, I was surprised to 30 find that I wasn't in a hurry to get my phone fixed. I had learned to appreciate the world around me and 31 32 the value of real connections.

33 When I finally did get my phone back, I decided 34 to set some boundaries. I no longer spend hours on 35 social media and make an effort to meet my friends 36 in person. I even keep my phone away from my bed 37 at night.

38 My phone breaking down was a blessing in 39 disguise. It taught me to unplug and experience life more fully. And though I'm glad to have it back, I'm 41 equally glad for the lessons those two weeks without it taught me.


