PROVA DE LÍNGUA INGLESA**SAFER DRIVING**

01 David Williams, a renowned driving safety
 02 expert, shares some advice on becoming a better
 03 driver. With more than three decades of experience
 04 in the field, David has extensive knowledge about
 05 safe and efficient driving. He knows more than
 06 anyone what makes a dangerous driver and what
 07 makes a safe one!

08 "Driving is an important responsibility and we
 09 should always take it seriously," begins David. "We
 10 often overlook the basics. Like, for instance, regular
 11 maintenance of your vehicle is crucial. A
 12 well-functioning vehicle can greatly reduce the risk
 13 of accidents."

14 He also emphasises the importance of being
 15 aware of one's surroundings while driving. "You
 16 have to keep an eye on what's happening around
 17 you - cars, pedestrians, cyclists. And remember, the
 18 road doesn't belong to you alone. You need to be
 19 aware that everyone on the road is equally
 20 important, that driver you are getting impatient with
 21 is someone's wife, or husband, or mother or son."

22 According to David, speed is a common factor
 23 in many accidents. People are often in such a hurry
 24 and the consequences can be terrible. "Sticking to
 25 the speed limit is not just about avoiding fines. It's
 26 about safety - both yours and others. Don't let
 27 impatience drive you to make poor decisions."

28 David also talks about the essential role of
 29 practice. "Experience is key. The more you practice,
 30 the more comfortable you become with handling
 31 unexpected situations. New drivers especially
 32 should gain experience in different weather
 33 conditions and at different times of the day." If you
 34 want to be a better driver, keep driving and keep
 35 driving safely!

36 These days, with so many distractions
 37 available to a driver in the car, it's never been so
 38 easy to take your attention off the road. As for
 39 distractions, David (1) ____ a straightforward
 40 message. "Stay away from your phone and don't
 41 multitask (2) _____. Your full attention should be on
 42 the road."

43 For David Williams, being a better driver is not
 44 about skill alone. It's about cultivating a sense of
 45 responsibility, improving awareness, practicing
 46 regularly, and most importantly, staying safe.
