**PROVA DE LÍNGUA INGLESA****DIFFERENT FAMILY BACKGROUNDS**

01 John and Philippa have been married for  
 02 almost 20 years, and their closeness is obvious  
 03 when you meet them. Their life together is based on  
 04 family values. Their three teenage children wander  
 05 in and out as we chat, and John's elderly mother  
 06 has her own set of rooms in their large Victorian  
 07 house. There is a strong sense of unity in their  
 08 home, of shared values and life goals.

09 Yet when they met as students on a year  
 10 abroad in India, their family backgrounds couldn't  
 11 have been more different. Philippa, the daughter of  
 12 a surgeon and a successful novelist, had been  
 13 educated at expensive private schools, and her  
 14 friends included an actress and the daughter of a  
 15 famous rock star. John, on the other hand, was  
 16 raised by a single mother in a tiny house in Los  
 17 Angeles and remembers going to bed hungry on  
 18 many occasions.

19 So what happened when these two very  
 20 different families came together? "Well, strangely  
 21 enough, it was my mother who objected to the  
 22 wedding, not Philippa's parents," John says with a  
 23 smile. "She was really concerned about social  
 24 status, and she honestly thought that marrying  
 25 someone from such a different family background  
 26 was a mistake. She thought I'd lose my identity."

27 And now?

28 John laughs. "She had this stereotype of an  
 29 upper-class person in her mind, and as soon as she  
 30 actually met Philippa, she discovered that we  
 31 weren't so different after all. Once she got to know  
 32 her as an individual, they got on really well. Of  
 33 course, money is an issue—how could it not be? —  
 34 but Philippa and her family have always been very  
 35 sensitive about it."

36 Before leaving, I asked Philippa if she thinks  
 37 that background is important at all when it comes to  
 38 choosing a life partner. She thinks for a moment.  
 39 "Well, it wasn't for us, but it would be silly to say that  
 40 it doesn't matter at all. You just have to be aware of  
 41 the possible problems and use your common  
 42 sense, that's all."
